Port users are advised that, based on the hydrographic surveys carried out on the belowmentioned berths and channels, the declared depths are published as indicated in the table.

Concerned stake holders / users are requested to take note of the changes to these depths.

## Note

- 1) All depths are in meters and at chart datum (i.e. **0.0** Mtr height of tide)
- 2) Minimum depth in approach channel and maneuvering basin for the month is -17.6 Mtrs.
- 3) Drafts at which vessel can sail anytime from AVPPL lowest low water on 04 Mar 2025 : **0.35 mtrs**: Vessels with draft < = **16.3 M** can sail anytime. Above drafts are basis on 10% UKC in the channel.
- 4) A minimum under keel clearance of 10% of the ship's draft" will be maintained during channel passage. A minimum UKC of 0.5 Mtrs will be maintained at all time when the vessel is alongside at the berth.
