USAGE OF THURAYA, IRIDIUM AND OTHER RESTRICTED SATELLITE COMMUNICATION SET IN INDIAN TERRITORIAL WATERS

Dear Sirs,

Usage of Thuraya, Iridium and other such Satellite Communication set is strictly prohibited at Vizhinjam International Seaport.

All agents are advised to inform Vessels calling under their agency to ensure strict compliance of DGS Order No. 02 of 2012, Circular No. 48-NT (1)/2012 dated 17.05.2012.

Subject: Usage of Thuraya, Irridum and other such Satellite Communication in

Indian Waters.

The Directorate is receipt of letter from Ministry of Shipping, along with copy of

MHA fax message No. 122014/HS/2011 dated 12/9/2011 on the above subject.

2. The use of Thuraya, Irridum and other such Satellite phone is banned in India

under Sec 6 of Indian Wireless Act and Sec 20 of Indian Telegraph Act. It is intimated to

all Shipping companies / Shipping agents that use of Thuraya, Irridum and other such

Satellite is banned in Indian waters and seafarers should not us the same.

3. Satellite phones can be used only after a no objection certificate is issued by

Department of Telecommunications (DOT) on a case to case basis.

4. The shipping agents should mandatorily intimate the details of person carrying

Thuraya and the particulars of Thuraya, Irridum and other such sets in Pre Arrival

Notification on Security (PANS).

The unauthorized holder of Thuraya, Irridum and other such Satellite phone can

be prosecuted under Sec 6 of Indian Wireless Act and Sec 20 of Indian Telegraph Act.

awareness.
