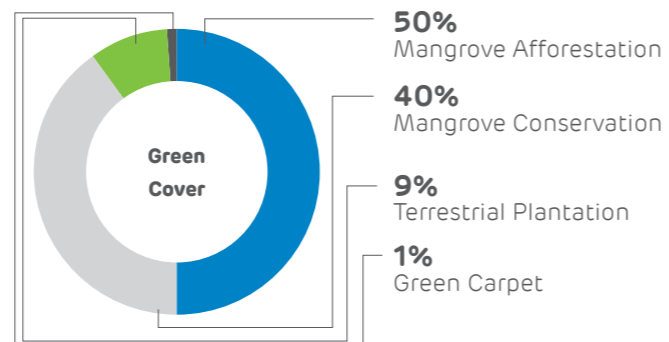
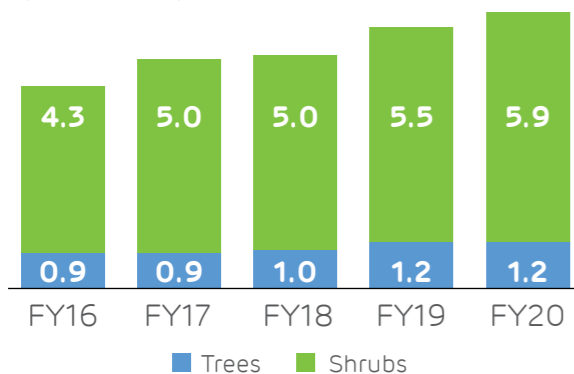

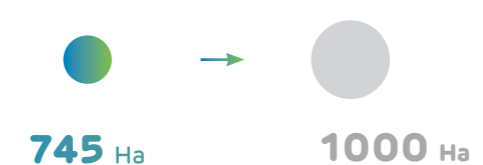
We and Mangroves are growing together

National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM) carried out detailed bathymetry and topography survey; sampling and analysis of physio-chemical and biological parameters of soil and water; survey of mangrove diversity and its health; tide and current data including its residence time; and focus group discussion with surrounding community of Mundra in 2016 -17 considering 2011 as base year. The study revealed that total mangrove cover increased by almost 250 Ha.

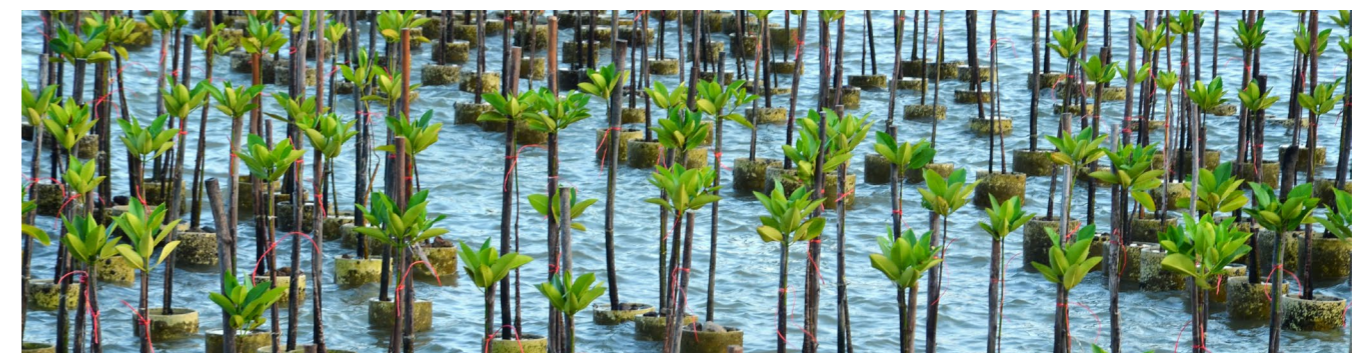
